

Andrean High School Uniform Policy

We believe the uniform policy to be an important aspect of the Andrean mission and remind our students to adhere to these policies. We will treat uniform infractions with disciplinary consequences as outlined in the Student Handbook. Students may be placed on probationary status, limiting them from their activities for excessive uniform infractions.

Fall & Spring Uniform (August - October and April - End of the School Year)
Winter Uniform (November 1-March 31)

Boys Fall/Spring Uniform:

- Tommy Hilfiger khaki pants worn at the waist
- Tommy Hilfiger khaki shorts (worn no more than 2 inches above the knees and may not be rolled)
- Belt (black, brown, or maroon) is **required** with shorts and pants
- Tommy Hilfiger white or red short-sleeve polo with Andrean Crest
- Uniform shirts **must be tucked into** uniform pants or shorts
- Undershirts must be white in all uniform options
- Socks may be white, navy, black, gray
 - Socks must be of solid color
 - Sock must be ankle or calf socks
- Shoes worn must be dress shoes, tennis\athletic shoes, or Ked\Sperry-like boat shoes

Unacceptable shoes include: Toms, UGGs, boots, slippers, moccasins, slides, sandals, flip flops, and high tops.

Boys Winter & Mass/Formal Occasion Uniform

- Tommy Hilfiger khaki pants worn at the waist with a belt
- Tommy Hilfiger Long Sleeve Blue or White Oxford with the Andrean tie
- Tommy Hilfiger Andrean Blazer with logo (**required on Mass\Formal wear days only**)
- Black, brown, tan, or maroon dress shoes (Sperry-type boat shoes are acceptable)
- (Tennis shoes are **not** acceptable on Mass \ Formal Uniform days)

Girls Fall/Spring Uniform:

- Plaid skirt worn no more than two inches above the knee and not rolled
- Tommy Hilfiger khaki pants worn with a belt at the waist
- Tommy Hilfiger khaki shorts must be loose fitted and worn no more than 2 inches above the knee and worn with a belt (may not be rolled)
- Belt (black or brown) must be worn with shorts and pants
- Tommy Hilfiger white or red polo with Andean Crest **must be worn tucked** into shorts, pants, and skirts.
- Shoes worn must be dress shoes, tennis\athletic shoes, or Ked\Sperry-like boat shoes
- Socks may be white, navy, gray, black
 - Socks must be worn below the knee and above the ankle

Girls Winter & Mass/Formal Occasion Uniform:

- Tommy Hilfiger Andean Blazer with logo (***required on Mass/Formal wear days only***)
- Tommy Hilfiger plaid skirt no more than two inches above the knee and not rolled *or* khaki pants
- Long sleeve White or Blue Oxford
 - **Shirt must be worn tucked into pants and skirt**
- Black, brown, tan, white, or maroon dress shoes must be worn with skirt
 - Sperry-type shoes are acceptable
 - Athletic or tennis shoes are not acceptable
 - Dress slip-on shoes should not be above the ankle (booties)
- Girls socks may be white, black, gray, navy of solid color
- Girls tights may be black, gray, navy of solid color without a pattern

Unacceptable shoes include: Toms, Uggs, slippers, boots, heels, sandals, slides, flip flops, moccasins, and mules.

Tattoos/Piercings/Hair

- Students may not have visible tattoos; they must be covered with uniform clothing
- Students may only wear up to two ear piercings; no other piercings are allowed and must be removed.
- Nose rings are not allowed (including nose plugs); they must be removed
- Boys' hair should be neatly trimmed; hair must be worn above the eye brow, ear, and collar line. Boys are not allowed to wear hair in any fashion that contradicts this norm (pony tail, bun, head band, etc.)
- Hair dye (pink, blue, green, etc.) is not allowed
- Shaved or etched designs are not allowed in hairstyle
- Mohawks are not allowed

- Boys may not have excessive facial hair; they may be asked to shave if they come to school unshaven.

Head coverings:

- Students are not allowed to wear hats or scarves that cover the head
- Headbands may be worn on top of the head no more than two inches wide
- Students who need to wear head coverings for religious purposes should discuss the matter with administration prior to doing so

Dress Down Days (Administration Approval)

- Clothes must be neat in appearance
- References made to alcohol, profanity or illegal substances may not be on clothing
- Jeans should be free of holes, rips and tears
- Jeans should be loose fitting and worn at the waist
- Leggings, Jeggings, Yoga Pants, and Pajama Pants are not allowed
- Sandals and slippers may not be worn
- Strapless and spaghetti tops may not be worn
- Hats or head covering may not be worn
- Shorts should be modest and no shorter than mid-length of the thigh (including running shorts)
