- Complete 5 Social Studies credits (World History, U.S. History, U.S. Government)
- Complete 2 PE / Health credits (PE I and Health)
- Complete Personal Finance, College & Career, Computer Science, and Speech
- Complete 4 World Language credits
- Complete 2 Fine Art credits
- Complete 8 Theology credits
- Complete 9 personalized electives

Honors Seal

Earn the Andrean Diploma credits, PLUS:

- Complete at least one extra Social Studies credit
- Earn a C or higher in all courses
- Overall GPA 3.0+
