Position Overview:

We are seeking a highly motivated High School teacher who has content knowledge and/or experience teaching Science.

The Teacher will:

1. Articulate course objectives that are aligned with the Indiana Department of Education for content area teaching;
2. Support the Diocese of Gary mission, and Andreas High School vision and four mission pillars of faith, learning, leadership, and service; and follows the guidelines as established in the Diocese of Gary Employee Handbook and the Andreas Employee Handbook;
3. Create a positive organized class, and deals with inappropriate behavior quickly and effectively according to the school behavior policy;
4. Develop lesson plans, adapt the curriculum to meet individual student needs, and utilize effective teaching techniques in translating lesson plans into productive student learning experiences which best utilize the time available for instruction.
5. Utilize computers and other technological classroom support equipment in student instruction.
6. Plan and conduct activities for a balanced program of instruction, demonstration, and work time that provides students with opportunities to observe, question, and investigate.
7. Evaluate academic and social growth of students, prepare quizzes, tests, and final exams. Keeps appropriate records to include student attendance reports, inventory, grades, and other recordkeeping activities as necessary; and
8. Attend department, all-school and Diocesan meetings, events, and professional development as required by the Andreas Administration.
