## Uniform and Dress Code

All families need to purchase uniforms from Dennis Uniforms located in Highland, IN, or from the Dennis website at [www.dennisuniform.com](http://www.dennisuniform.com). All uniform options are sold by Dennis Uniform. If the item cannot be purchased there, then it is not part of the uniform and should not be worn. Used uniforms can be purchased through the “Andean High School Parent Page” on Facebook.

*We believe the uniform and dress code policy to be an important aspect of the Andean mission and ask our students to adhere to these policies. We will treat uniform infractions with disciplinary consequences as outlined below:*

- If it can be fixed, students should do so when told. Teachers may give warnings, informal detentions, or contact parents/guardians for uniform infractions.
  - Students who do not fix the uniform when told will be written up and will receive a referral and potential detention for that action (similar to the tardy policy).
- Students missing a part of the uniform (specifically the *polo* or *ID*) will be sent to the office to **purchase** one.
- Students who have excessive uniform infractions will be disciplined and potentially placed on Behavioral Contract.
- Please note that administration reserves the right to send a student home if they are not in adherence to appropriate uniform guidelines as they deem necessary.

**ALL SCHOOL UNIFORM:** All uniforms and shoes must be neat in appearance without visible tears or holes.

*Note: during Fall and Spring, shorts are allowed (from First Day – October 31 and April 1 – Last Day)<sup>1</sup>.*

- Dennis, long-sleeve, Blue or White **Oxford** w/crest.<sup>2</sup>
  - Andean Macbeth **tie** is required for *boys only*.
  - Undershirts must be white in all uniform options.
  - Uniform shirts must be tucked into uniform pants or shorts.
- Dennis **pants** in khaki with Andean Logo, worn loose fitted.
  - (*optional for girls*) Andean Macbeth Skirt - see *Girls Skirt uniform code*
- **Belt** is required with shorts and pants.

<sup>1</sup> These dates *may* be adjusted due to weather by administration.

<sup>2</sup> The Oxford is *required* at Mass, representing Andean, and at other times when the Administration states.

## OPTIONAL/Additional UNIFORM (for all students)

- (optional) Dennis, white or red, short- or long-sleeve **polo shirt** with Andean Crest <sup>3</sup>
  - Uniform shirts must be tucked into uniform pants or shorts.
- (optional) to be worn over the polo or Oxford<sup>4</sup>
  - Gray, quarter zip sweatshirt with Andean Crest
  - Red cardigan with Andean Crest
  - Red V-neck pullover sweater with Andean Crest.
  - Red vest with Andean Crest
- (optional - only for Fall/Spring<sup>5</sup>) Dennis **shorts** in khaki with Andean Logo
  - may be hemmed but not rolled.
  - Length must extend beyond the fingertips when arms are hanging freely and fingers are extended.

## SKIRT UNIFORM Code (optional for GIRLS)

- Girls may wear the **Dennis Andean Macbeth plaid skirt**
  - may be hemmed but not rolled.
  - Length must extend beyond the fingertips when arms are hanging freely and fingers are extended.
  - Oxford<sup>6</sup> must be worn tucked into skirt, *or*
  - the Polo<sup>7</sup> may be worn untucked.
- Tights may be of *solid color without a pattern*

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<sup>3</sup> Polos may be worn year-round, but not on Mass Days or other days so designated by Administration.

<sup>4</sup> Only the uniform sweatshirt or cardigan is allowed. You may **not** wear Andean Wear, coats, jackets, blankets, etc. *Senior wear is only allowed on designated days.*

<sup>5</sup> First Day – October 31 and April 1 – Last Day

<sup>6</sup> The Oxford is *required* at Mass, representing Andean, and at other times when the Administration states.

<sup>7</sup> Polos may be worn year-round, but not on Mass Days.

## ALL SCHOOL DRESS CODE

- **Student ID** must be kept on their person.
  - a lanyard will be provided so students may wear them around their necks.
  - Since the Student ID is associated with the student's lunch account, no ID means lunch cannot be purchased. Students may buy a new ID.
- **Closed toe and closed heel shoes** must be worn.
  - Unacceptable shoes include, but are not limited to: slippers, moccasins, slides, sandals, flip flops, mules, and Crocs
- Students may not have visible tattoos. They must be covered with clothing or wrapping.
- Students may only wear up to two ear lobe piercings.
  - no other piercings are allowed and must be removed including, but not limited to: nose, tongue, ear bar, and plastic plugs.
- Hair should be neat in appearance.
  - Unnatural hair dye (red, pink, blue, green, etc.) is not allowed.
- Facial hair should be neat in appearance.
- Students are not allowed to wear hats, or scarves that cover the head.
  - Students who need to wear head coverings for religious purposes should discuss the matter with the administration prior to doing so.

### Dress Down Days (per Administration Approval)

*Besides the school uniform, all other dress code requirements are still enforced (see above).*

*There are two types of Dress Down Days:*

1. Andean Wear: students will wear an Andean shirt or sweatshirt with appropriate pants.
  2. Theme Days: students will meet the theme of the day through their outfit: shirt and/or pants.
- All clothing must be neat in appearance: free of holes, rips, and tears.
  - Pants should be loose-fitting and worn at the waist.
  - Shorts or skirts should be modest and length must extend beyond the fingertips when arms are hanging freely and fingers are extended.
  - Not allowed:
    - Leggings, jeggings, and yoga pants
    - Tank, strapless, and spaghetti tops
    - Plunging necklines and midriff tops
    - References to alcohol, profanity, or illegal substances may not be on the clothing.
